FIREARMS ARE INHERENTLY DANGEROUS, AND IF MISUSED, MAY CAUSE GREAT HARM, INJURY OR DEATH

Firearms are inherently dangerous, and if misused, may cause great harm, injury or death. You are responsible for becoming thoroughly familiar with the safe and proper use of your firearm under all conditions and at all times before using this product.

You are also responsible for insuring that your firearm is in proper, safe operating condition.

KEEP FIREARMS OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN

Keep firearms out of the reach of children. Follow all instructions provided by the manufacturer of your firearm. Store firearms properly in a secure locking storage safe designed for the storage of such. Never leave a firearm unattended.

NEVER LEAVE A FIREARM UNATTENDED

No person should handle any firearm unless such person has successfully passed an accredited firearms safety program. You can obtain proper training in safe firearms handling through accredited programs conducted through police departments, State run hunter safety programs and other organizations such as the National Rifle Association.

Edge-Works G-CODE holsters are designed to fit and work only with specific, modern, factory-equipped handguns. A holster should be used only with the gun specified for that holster. The use of trigger shoes, grip adapters and or other modifications could cause the gun to fit improperly and possibly discharge accidentally. Modified or customized guns should not be used in Edge-Works G-Code holsters, nor should worn or broken guns, or guns of inferior quality or design.

NEVER ALTER OR MODIFY YOUR HOLSTER

Never alter or modify your holster. Only use your holster in conjunction with a quality “shooting belt” designed for the specific purpose of supporting and facilitating the carry of a holstered firearm. Belts not specifically designed for this purpose may not adequately support and retain the holster.

Prior to use the holster must be inspected by a qualified individual along with the intended handgun to be used to insure and verify a proper fit and that the intended hand gun and holster function properly together. An improper fit could lead to an accidental discharge.

NEVER PLACE A LOADED HANDGUN IN A HOLSTER WITHOUT FIRST TESTING IT COMPLETELY IN AN UNLOADED CONDITION

Always point your handgun in a safe direction and use extreme caution when holstering or unholstering your gun. If your firearm is so equipped, and functions in such a way to comply with all other precautions, then always make sure that it is “on safe” before holstering. Never have your finger on the trigger or in the trigger guard when holstering. Keep your fingers and clothing, and any other objects out of the holster and out of the trigger guard while you holster and draw your gun as you may accidentally discharge the gun. When holstering the firearm make sure that you do not accidentally push back the slide. Always place your thumb on the back of the slide or hammer to hold the slide and hammer forward when holstering. Before you wear any holster make sure that nothing will affect your draw. Practice drawing and holstering your firearm but never practice with a loaded gun. You are responsible to check the proper fit and function before each use and periodically during use. Any product will wear out in time, or could become damaged or have a defect. **Should any G-CODE product become worn, ill-fitting, or defective, CEASE USE IMMEDIATELY.**

KEEP FIREARMS OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN

Carrying any handgun with a live cartridge in the chamber immediately in front of the firing pin may cause an accidental discharge. All handguns are only to be carried with the firing mechanism and firing pin resting on an empty chamber. Firearms should be un-cocked while they are in the holster. Never carry “cocked and locked” unless the maker of your firearm states that you can safely carry it in this way and you are specifically trained and certified to safely carry it this way in your holster. You are responsible for exercising extreme caution when handling or carrying any handgun. You must always assume that the gun is loaded and able to fire. Never attempt to cock a firearm while it is in the holster as such could result in an accidental discharge.

Regardless of your holsters retention capabilities, always hold your gun in place by hand during vigorous physical activity to avoid the gun falling from the holster. The responsibility of carrying a firearm demands constant attention and awareness. No holster is “take away” proof. **You are responsible to prevent situations where another individual would have opportunity to take away your handgun.**
